

Information about your new Implant Prosthesis

We have done our best to provide you with a well-fitted, functional, and esthetic implant prosthesis. We feel confident that you will have many years of satisfaction and use from them. The following information is important for you to understand:

For several days, please chew more carefully on these restorations than on natural teeth. We will adjust the bite (occlusion) on future appointments, if necessary, until it is very well balanced. After you have adjusted to the prosthesis, it should function in a very similar manner to natural teeth.

Cleaning the implant and prosthesis: The continuing success of the implant and prosthesis is up to you. Please do the following:

1. Visit us for examination and cleaning at least once every _____ months.
2. Clean the implant(s) daily, especially before bedtime using:

- _____ Peridex

Please ask us about anything that is unclear to you on the subject of cleaning your implant prosthesis.

Regular visits for examination and professional maintenance are very important to the long-term success of your prosthesis.

Please contact us if any of the conditions below occur:

1. Feeling of looseness
2. Peculiar taste
3. Clicking or metallic snap while eating
4. Breakage of a piece of the prosthesis
5. Redness in the gum tissue around the implant
6. Feeling of the bite being different
7. Pain
